RULES

1. Refer to General Rules, Livestock Health Rules & Regulations, Care Guidelines, and Code of Show Ring Ethics.
2. An "Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship" form and proper Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be submitted to the Show supervisors upon arrival at the Fairgrounds and before any animals can be unloaded from trailers/trucks.
3. Each exhibitor shall be limited to two (2) entries in any one class, including individual ewe and ram classes. Each exhibitor may receive two premiums in this class. Only one group prize will be paid to any single exhibitor in a class.
4. Families must exhibit together, i.e. join their entries for flock, individual and pair classes, or if individual family members have sheep registered in their names, they may show in the individual classes but may not combine other family-owned sheep to make a group class.
5. Market Lambs are shown in Weight Classes in 4-H/FFA Dept. 10 only. Market Lambs may be shown in Open Class Fitting and Showmanship classes.
6. If a specific breed does not have at least three (3) exhibitors with a total of 15 animals exhibited each year for two consecutive years, that breed will be dropped from the show classification the following year.
7. A Pen of Lambs consists of four (4) lambs, both sexes represented, and all owned by one (1) exhibitor.
8. A Flock consists of one (1) ram, any age; two (2) ewes one year and under two years; and two (2) ewes under one year, and all owned by one (1) exhibitor.
9. Breeder's Flock consists of one (1) ram lamb and two (2) ewe lambs all bred and owned by the Exhibitor.
10. A Get-of-Sire shall consist of four (4) breeding animals, any age or sex the get of one (1) sire. Get must be owned by the exhibitor.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. All sheep must be identified with official U.S.D.A scapic identification. Sheep from flocks on the Scrapie Flock Certification Program must bear an official eartag, tattoo, RDIF eartag or electronic implant device (the exhibitor must supply a reader). (2008)
2. Exhibitor is responsible for contacting the USDA to obtain scrapie eartags (717-237-7440). Orders taken weekdays from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm. Orders may take several weeks to process, so early orders are recommended. (1/30/06)
3. Rabies vaccinations are recommended. All drug and vaccine label directions should be followed, including but not limited to slaughter withdrawal periods. The vaccine must be administered at least fifteen (15) days prior to entry into the exhibition.
4. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within the thirty (30) days prior to the opening date of the exhibition is required. It must include 1) a statement that the flock of origin was inspected and found free from symptoms of infectious or contagious disease and 2) a statement that this flock has had no known exposure to or history of scrapie.
5. Health Requirements for Out of State Sheep are available upon request.
