RULES

1. Refer to General Rules, Livestock Health Rules & Regulations, Care Guidelines, and Code of Show Ring Ethics.
2. An "Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship" form and proper Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must accompany each exhibition animal and must be submitted to the Show supervisors upon arrival at the Fairgrounds and before any animals can be unloaded from trailers/trucks.
3. The Show is not a sanctioned show.
4. Only Does entered in individual age classes may compete in the Get-of-Sire, Produce of Dam, and Best (3) Does Classes. Dam & Daughter (any age) need not be owned by one exhibitor.
5. Get-of-Sire shall consist of three Doe from a particular sire with not more than one under one year old allowed. The exhibitor need not own the 3 does in the Get-of-Sire class. No Get-of-Sire for Recorded Grades from an unregistered Sire. Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Sire. One exhibitor may not exhibit more than two (2) entries in one Get-of-Sire class.
6. Produce of Dam shall consist of two Doe of different ages, the produce of one dam. Exhibitor must own at least one Doe in a Produce of Dam. Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Dam. No exhibitor may exhibit more than two (2) entries in any one Produce of Dam class.
7. Best (3) Does shall consist of three milking doe of one breed, any age, all owned by one exhibitor or exhibiting family, and shall be limited to one entry.
8. Base date for computing age is July 21, 2008.
9. Milk out time shall be at the discretion of the exhibitor.
10. Dairy Goat exhibitors to furnish hay, grain, etc. The Fair Committee will furnish water.
11. The Senior Champion class shall consist of all first place winners from Classes 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10. The Junior

Champion class shall consist of all first place winners from Classes 1, 2, and 3. Grand Champion class shall consist of the Junior and Senior Champion.

12. If a specific breed does not have at least three (3) exhibitors with a total of ten (10) milking does exhibited each year, the breed will be put into an "All Other Purebred" class or dropped from the Show.
13. Any substitution must be made only within its own breed and must be owned by that exhibitor. All substitutions will be charged a \$1.00/change fee.
14. The Fair Committee reserves the right to change unofficial breeds to "All Other Purebreds" status. Exhibitors will be notified of any changes.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. Individual official animal identification is required. Official ID includes:
 - a. A scrapie eartag (contact the USDA to obtain scrapie eartags at 717-237-7440, weekdays from 8 AM to 5 PM. Your order may take several weeks for processing, so order tags early); or
 - b. An RFID tag; or
 - c. A scrapie tattoo. Goats with an official scrapie tattoo must also have a unique individual animal ID to meet the scrapie ID requirement; or
 - d. Goats having a breed registration tattoo and accompanied by a registration certificate are exempt from the scrapie ID requirement if the tattoo is legible and a registration certificate (copy acceptable) or a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection which lists the tattoo and registry accompanies the animal at all times during transport from the premises of birth; or
 - e. A breed registration electronic implant device (the exhibitor must supply a reader). (2008)
2. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within the thirty (30) days prior to the opening date of the exhibition is required.
3. No goats showing clinical sign of contagious or infectious disease, including casesous lymphadenitis, sore mouth, active ringworm, foot rot, warts, lice, mange, and abscesses will be admitted to any show.
4. Rabies vaccination is recommended. All drug and vaccine label directions must be followed, including but not limited to milk and slaughter withdrawal periods. The vaccine must be administered at least fifteen (15) days prior to entry into the exhibition.
