RULES

1. Refer to *General Rules, Livestock Health Rules & Regulations, Care Guidelines, and Code of Show Ring Ethics.*
2. Each exhibitor is **limited to two (2) entries in any one class**, unless otherwise noted.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1, 2011 is required. (2010)
2. An *Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship (VCPR)* form must accompany each animal and must be presented upon arrival at the fairgrounds.
3. Individual official animal identification is required. Official ID includes a USDA-issued metal eartag; or a breed registration tattoo if the tattoo is legible and the animal is accompanied by a copy of the registration certificate; or a breed registration eartag if the animal is accompanied by a copy of the registration certificate; or an ISO-compliant 15-digit eartag (including RFID). (2010)

4. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases. A statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is pre-printed on the CVI). Cattle appearing to be unhealthy upon arrival, including any visible signs of ringworm, warts, lice and mange, will **NOT** be allowed to enter the grounds. (2009)
5. PA Cattle Vaccination Requirements:
 - a. Current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals 3 months of age and older. (2009)
 - b. All vaccine label directions must be followed, and all rabies vaccinated cattle must be accompanied by a Rabies Vaccination Certificate (a copy is acceptable) or the vaccination information must be included on the CVI. (2009)
 - c. If a Rabies Vaccination Certificate (or a copy) is provided, the certificate must contain legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine along with the veterinarian's signature. (2009)
6. Out of State Cattle
Health Requirements for Out of State Cattle for Exhibition are available upon request.

- 08 Junior heifer calf born between March 1, 2011 and May 1, 2011
- 09 Intermediate heifer calf born between Dec. 1, 2010 and Feb. 28, 2011
- 10 Senior heifer calf born between Sept. 1, 2010 and Nov. 30, 2010
- 11 Summer yearling heifer calf born between June 1, 2010 and Aug. 31, 2010
- 12 Junior yearling heifer born between March 1, 2010 and May 31, 2010
- 13 Intermediate yearling heifer born between Dec. 1, 2009 and February 28, 2010
- 14 Senior yearling heifer born between Sept. 1, 2009 and Nov. 30, 2009
- 15 JUNIOR CHAMPION FEMALE
- 16 RESERVE JUNIOR CHAMPION FEMALE
- 17 Junior Best 3 Females; 3 females from the heifer classes, none of which have been freshened, bred and owned by the exhibitor
- 18 Dry cow 3 year (must have gone through at least one lactation)
- 19 Junior 2 year old born between March 1, 2009 and Aug. 31, 2009
- 20 Senior 2 year old born between Sept. 1, 2008 and Feb. 28, 2009
- 21 3 year old born between Sept. 1, 2007 and Aug. 31, 2008
- 22 4 year old born between Sept. 1, 2006 and Aug. 31, 2007
- 23 5 years and over born before Sept. 1, 2006
- 24 SENIOR CHAMPION FEMALE
- 25 RESERVE SENIOR CHAMPION FEMALE
- 26 GRAND CHAMPION FEMALE
- 27 RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION FEMALE
- 28 Cow in milk, any age, to be judged on udder alone (no dry cow)
- 29 Senior Get-of-Sire; 3 animals age 2 years or over; need not all be from one herd
- 30 Senior Best 3 females that have freshened; bred and owned by exhibitor
- 31 Dairy Herd; 3 cows that have freshened, all owned by one exhibitor or exhibitor family
- 32 Produce of Dam; 2 females any age, the produce of one cow; need not be owned by one exhibitor
- 33 Dam and daughter; any age; need not be owned by one exhibitor
