NOTES

1. This Department is open only to Youth Exhibitors age 7 through and including 18.
2. Refer to General Rules for age cut-off dates.
3. The Youth Exhibitor must have made the entry since the last Fair. Judges have the right to disqualify any entries from Department 11 if they determine that an adult made the entry.
4. Some entries will be judged in two age groups: 7-13 years and 14-18 years (refer to each Section for groupings).
5. Department 011 entries may not be the same article as one entered under 4-H Department 010.

RULES

1. Refer to General Rules.
2. The use of artificial flowers in displays is prohibited
3. Plants must have been growing in containers for two months. The management is not responsible for the return of exhibits. Baskets or containers must be supplied by exhibitor and will be given every possible care; but the management assumes no responsibility for their safety.
4. Flowers or plants entered for competition must be of extraordinary standards.
5. Exhibitor must grow all entries.
6. Judges may award an "Honorable Mention" ribbon at their discretion
7. Exhibits in the Specimen Flowers division must be cut flowers grown by the exhibitor and must conform to the number of blooms, spikes or stems as specified in each class.
8. Exhibits in the Specimen Flowers division must be of one color and variety (unless otherwise stated) and in a **totally clear glass container**.
9. Ages 7 to 18 may enter these classes.

- 01 African Violet, single or double, any color
- 02 Begonias, single or double, any color, rooted in bloom
- 03 Geranium, Pelargonium, bedding or common, any color
- 04 Any other meritorious flowering house plant not mentioned above
- 05 Hanging Basket - flowering

CLASS

- 01 Begonias, foliage type without flowers, any variety
- 03 Coleus, any leaf color
- 04 Ferns, any variety
- 05 Geranium, Pelargonium, any variety
- 06 Potted Ivy, any variety
- 07 Dish garden or terrarium - three or more specimens in a container
- 08 Philodendron, any variety
- 09 Spider Plant
- 10 Hanging Basket - foliage type without flowers
- 11 Succulent (plants that store water in their leaves or stems other than cactus)
- 12 Cactus (any varieties)
- 13 Any other meritorious non-flowering house plant not mentioned above

- 01 Ageratum - 5 stems
- 02 Marigolds, Yellow - 5 blooms
- 03 Marigolds, Orange - 5 blooms
- 04 Marigolds, Bi-Color - 5 blooms
- 05 Nasturtiums - 5 blooms
- 06 Pansy - 5 blooms
- 07 Petunias, single - 5 blooms
- 08 Petunias, double - 5 blooms
- 09 Snapdragons - 5 spikes
- 10 Zinnias, small (under 3") - 5 blooms
- 11 Zinnias, large (3" or more) - 5 blooms

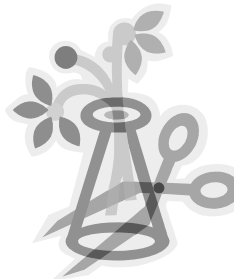

CLASS

- 01 Dahlias - 1 bloom
- 02 Gladiolus - 1 spike
- 03 Lily, any color - 1 bloom
- 04 Daylily, any color - 1 bloom
- 05 Any other perennial - **3 stems or 3 blooms**, same size, height and color (*identify name of perennial on tag*)

All specimen flower entries must be in a **clear glass container** and must have the **correct number of blooms** as indicated in the Class listings.
