**Judging Day:** Saturday, July 24; Baked Goods only on Monday, July 26

### NOTES

1. This Department is open only to Youth Exhibitors age 7 through and including 18.
2. Refer to General Rules for age cut-off dates.
3. The Youth Exhibitor must have made the entry since the last Fair. Judges have the right to disqualify any entries from Department 11 if they determine that an adult made the entry.
4. Some entries will be judged in two age groups: 7-13 years and 14-18 years (refer to each Section for groupings).
5. Department 011 entries may not be the same article as one entered under 4-H Department 010.

## DEPT. 011 ART & HANDCRAFT

**Entry fee:** None unless exhibitor's total number of items from all Departments exceeds 10 (see Entry Form for fee schedule).

**Registration Deadline:** June 30

**Entries Received:** Friday, July 23 - 7:00 - 9:00 p.m.  
And Saturday, July 24 - 9:00 - 11:00 a.m.

**Judging Day:** Saturday, July 24

**Entries Released:** Sunday, Aug 1, Noon to 2:00 p.m.

### RULES

1. Refer to General Rules.
2. This section includes articles made by methods other than stitchery.
3. The Youth exhibitor must have made all exhibits - no commercial articles accepted.
4. Ceramic articles should have identification marks to indicate that they are originals, and must be dated after the close of the last Fair.
5. All artwork, wall hangings and wreaths must be ready to hang with wire, cord or hooks. Framing will be used as criteria in judging.
6. Judges may award an "Honorable Mention" at their discretion.
7. The clothing used for decorative painting need not be handmade.
8. **Age Categories:** 7 to 13 and 14 to 18.

YOUTH PHOTOGRAPHY  
SECTION 19G**

**RULES**

1. The youth exhibitor must have taken the photo. One entry per person per class.
2. All entries must be clearly marked on the back of the photo with a) Photo Title, b) Entrant's Name, c) Direction of Top Edge of the photo, d) the Category (see below), and e) Date Taken.
3. All entries must be color prints. Print size : 8" x 10" only!
4. Enter the PHOTO ONLY. No mountings, mattes or frames. Fair will provide the plastic page protectors.
5. The youth exhibitor must have taken the photographs since January 2009, and the photo may not have been entered before in the Kimberton Community Fair.
6. Any camera may be used (ex: 35mm, digital, etc.) However, using any editing tools to duplicate, create, or move major elements of the digital photo is not permitted.

**JUDGING CRITERIA**

Photo is judged on color, focus, composition, and impact.

01 **Fair Catalog Cover Design**

  - d) Competitive Exhibits Catalog
