RULES

1. Refer to General Rules.
2. The use of artificial flowers in displays is prohibited
3. Plants must have been growing in containers for two months. The management is not responsible for the return of exhibits. Baskets or containers must be supplied by exhibitor and will be given every possible care; but the management assumes no responsibility for their safety.
4. Flowers or plants entered for competition must be of extraordinary standards.
5. Exhibitor must grow all entries.
6. Judges may award an "Honorable Mention" ribbon at their discretion
7. Exhibits in the Specimen Flowers division must be cut flowers grown by the exhibitor and must conform to the number of blooms, spikes or stems as specified in each class.
8. Exhibits in the Specimen Flowers division must be of one color and variety (unless otherwise stated) and in a **clear glass container** (no colorations or designs on glass).

- 01 African Violet, single or double, any color

FOLIAGE HOUSEPLANTS

- 01 Begonias, foliage type without flowers, any variety
- 03 Coleus, any leaf color
- 04 Ferns, any variety
- 05 Geranium, Pelargonium, any variety

- 07 Dish garden or terrarium - three or more specimens in a container
- 08 Philodendron, any variety
- 09 Spider Plant
- 10 Hanging Basket - foliage type without flowers
- 11 Succulent (plants that store water in their leaves or stems other than cactus)
- 12 Cactus (any varieties)
- 13 Caladium
- 14 Any other meritorious non-flowering house plant not mentioned above

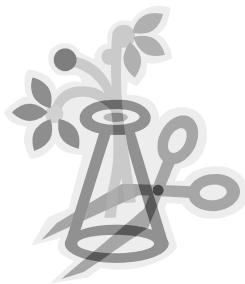

- 05 Nasturtiums - 5 blooms
- 06 Pansy - 5 blooms
- 07 Petunias, single - 5 blooms
- 08 Petunias, double - 5 blooms
- 09 Snapdragons - 5 spikes
- 10 Zinnias, small (under 3") - 5 blooms
- 11 Zinnias, large (3" or more) - 5 blooms
- 12 Any Other Annual - 5 blooms

CLASS - in a clear glass container

- 01 Dahlias - 1 bloom
- 02 Cactus - 1 bloom
- 03 Gladiolus - 1 spike
- 04 Lily, any color - 1 bloom
- 05 Daylily, any color - 1 bloom
- 06 Phlox - 1 bloom
- 07 Hydrangeas - 1 bloom
- 08 Coneflowers - 1 bloom
- 09 Hosta - 1 stem or leaf
- 10 Any other perennial - **3 stems or 3 blooms**, same size, height and color (*identify name of perennial*)



Remember . . .
All specimen flower entries must be in a **clear glass container** (no colorations or designs on glass) and must have the **correct number of blooms** as indicated in the Class listings.

DEPT. 017 - SECTION 05 SPECIAL CONTEST PRIZE WINNING ROSES

NOTES

1. Rose must be a fresh cut flower grown by the exhibitor.
2. Entry shall consist of **two (2) blooms**, same variety and color, and exhibited **in a clear, glass vase** (no colorations or designs on glass).
3. Rose must be 1/3 to 1/2 open at the time of judging.
4. Exhibitor must **identify the variety** at the time of entry check-in.
5. Maximum care will be taken of the containers until exhibitor reclaims them, but the Fair Committee is not responsible for damage or loss.
6. Best of Show chosen from among the First Place Winners from Classes 01 through 06 (*Rosette Award*)

JUDGING CRITERIA

Condition, Substance (freshness), Stem, Sepals, and Foliage in proportion to the bloom.

CLASS - in a clear, glass vase

- 01 Miniature Roses, Red - 2 blooms
- 02 Miniature Roses, Pink - 2 blooms
- 03 Miniature Roses, All other colors - 2 blooms

- 05 All other varieties, Pink - 2 blooms
- 06 All other varieties, All other colors - 2 blooms

DEPT. 017 - SECTION 06 FRESH FLOWER ARTISTIC ARRANGEMENTS

NOTES:

1. Maximum care will be taken of the containers and accessories until exhibitor reclaims them, but the Fair Committee is not responsible for damage or loss.
2. Arrangements must contain all **fresh plant material**. No artificial plant material permitted.
3. Accessories are not permitted
4. Arrangements made by professional florists will not be accepted.

5. Best of Show chosen from among the First Place Winners of Classes 01-08.

CLASS

- 01 Arrangement - wreath
 02 Arrangement - vase
 03 Arrangement - basket
 04 **Floral Topiary** - arrangement designed to resemble some object
 05 **"Monochromatic"** - arrangement using only one color with its various tints and tones
 06 **"Baby"** - arrangement appropriate colors and materials for birth of baby
 07 **"Unique Container"** - arrangement using something not normally used for flower arrangement
 08 **"Handheld Bouquet"** - bouquet arrangement designed to be hand held and having the bulk of the material wire (*can be entered set in a clear vase with water*)

Judging Day: Sunday, July 25, 1:00 p.m.

Entries Released: Sunday, Aug 1, Noon to 2:00 p.m.

NOTES:

- Arrangement to be created as a timed event in front of the judges.
- Exhibitor = an individual.
- The exhibitor will create a garden arrangement planted directly inside of a wheelbarrow in 30 minutes.
- Exhibitor must supply all plants, potting material, planting tools, accessories and the wheelbarrow for this contest.
- The Fair will provide a contest area for the entries to be assembled in the Livestock Show ring (covered

pavilion). Exhibitor must clean up any materials, soil and tools from this area at the end of the contest.

6. Wheelbarrow must be able to be moved after judging. The Fair reserves the right to display the wheelbarrow gardens outside for decorative purposes.
7. Fresh flowers, potted plants (annuals or perennials) and other landscaping materials are acceptable (greenery, pinecones, grasses, etc)
8. Accessories are permitted, but the arrangement must be 75% plant material.
9. Any non-plant accessories must be weather-proof.
10. No food products that will spoil may be used.
11. Arrangements made by professional florists will not be accepted.
