### PURPOSE

To encourage the promotion and understanding of agricultural fairs. The Fair Queen and Ambassadors promote our fair and our County's agriculture, while gaining personal and professional growth and development. The Fair Queen Program provides each participant the opportunity to build and enhance confidence in her abilities, poise in her presentations, pride in her accomplishments, skills in communication, knowledge of the fair industry and sportsmanship. A scholarship is presented to the selected Queen, and she will have the opportunity to represent our fair at the PA Fair Queen Contest in January 2012.

**Registration Deadline:** May 30, 2011

**Judging:** June 18

**Crowning:** Monday, July 25, 2011 at Opening Ceremony

### STATE RULES

Each Fair Queen contestant must

1. Be a female who is a U.S. citizen and a resident of Pennsylvania.
2. Be at least age 16, but no older than 20, years of age as of June 1 of the year entering the local contest.
3. Be certified as the winner by the local fair where she was crowned.
4. Have not been a former local Fair Queen winner, nor a former State Fair Queen contestant.
5. Not hold any other title for any other commodity group or pageant during her reign.
6. Have her parent(s)' or guardian(s)' consent to enter the competition.
7. Be single, have never been married, have not been pregnant nor given birth to a child.
8. Act in accordance with the PA Fair Queen "Behavior Policy".
9. Meet all time commitments, Queen obligations and Dress Code as set forth by the PA Fair Queen Program.

### FAIR-SPECIFIC RULES

In addition to the State rules, Kimberton Fair has additional contest eligibility, obligations and judging rules. Contact Louise Kritzberger for complete details.

### JUDGING CRITERIA

1. **Written essay** on "What Kimberton Community Fair Means To My Community". Essay must be 300 words or less.
2. **3-5 minute Speech** on "Why You Should Come to the Kimberton Community Fair". Cue cards may be utilized. Props may be used if they enhance the speech. Computer based presentations are not permitted. This should be a persuasive speech appropriate for an adult audience.
3. **Personal Interview** with the panel of judges.

### AWARD

**First Place - \$500.00 Scholarship** for higher education. Sponsored by Kimberton Community Fair (*winner must meet eligibility requirements*)

- Kimberton Fair's Winner becomes eligible to compete at the State Competition in Hershey, PA in January 2012 where 1<sup>st</sup> place is awarded a \$2,000 scholarship.
