#### **RULES**

- Be certified as the winner by the local fair where she was crowned
- Have not been a former local Fair Queen winner, nor a former PA Fair Queen contestant.
- Not hold any other State title for any other commodity group or pageant during her reign.
- Have her parent(s)' or guardian(s)' consent to enter the competition.
- Be single, have never been married, have not been pregnant nor given birth to a child.
- 8. Act in accordance with the PA Fair Queen "Behavior Policy"
- Meet all time commitments, Queen obligations and "Dress Code" as set forth by the PA Fair Queen Program

#### FAIR-SPECIFIC RULES

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Written essay on "What Kimberton Community Fair Means To My Community". Essay must be 300 words or less.
- 3-5 minute Speech on "Why You Should Come to the Kimberton Community Fair". Cue cards may be utilized. Props may be used if they enhance the speech. Computer based presentations are <u>not</u> permitted. This should be a persuasive speech appropriate for an adult audience.
- 3. Personal Interview with the panel of judges.

#### **AWARD**

First Place - \$1,000.00 Scholarship for higher education. Sponsored by Kimberton Community Fair (winner must meet eligibility requirements)
