Rabbits and Cavies - OPEN CLASS

Entry Fee: \$1.00 per head (must pre-pay or pay at Livestock check in)

Registration Deadline: July 11

Entries Received: Saturday, July 25, 8:00 am-12:00 Noon

Judging Day: Saturday, July 25, 1:00 pm - All breeds

Entries Released: Saturday, July 25 after 7:00 pm

RULES

1. Refer to General Rules, Livestock Health Rules & Regulations, Care Guidelines, and Code of Show Ring Ethics.
2. There is no maximum number of entries per class.
3. If a specific breed does not have at least three (3) exhibitors with a total of 15 animals exhibited each year for two consecutive years, that breed may be dropped from the show classification the following year.
4. Breeding class rabbits must be a recognized breed by ARBA.
5. No rabbits under 3 months old or over 2 weeks pregnant will be allowed.
6. All youth are eligible to enter the Showmanship classes.
7. Cavy show will follow the Rabbit show.
8. Rabbit and Cavies show exhibitors should wear a clean long sleeve shirt, long pants and closed toe shoes while in the show ring. Aprons may be worn.
9. Class order may be changed at the discretion of the superintendent and/or judge.
10. The Fair will not be responsible for any loss, injury, or damage occurring while animals are in the exhibition ring.
11. Exhibitors are responsible for setting up/ tearing down own cages
12. Exhibitors must clean out bedding from pen(s) before leaving grounds.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. A Veterinary-Client-Patient Relationship (VCPR) must exist for all animals to be exhibited. This requirement can be fulfilled in any of the following means:
 - a. A VCPR Form with veterinarian's signature.
 - b. A signed statement on the Fair's Entry Form for the animal(s) being exhibited. "I attest and affirm that a "veterinary consultation relationship" - as that phrase is defined in the Animal Exhibition Sanitation Law found at 3 Pa. C.S.A. 2501 et seq. and any amendments thereto

- exists with regard to any animals I will be exhibiting."

- c. A valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (VCVI) - valid for thirty (30) days after the date of issuance and for only one destination.
 - d. The Fair will retain copies of the Entry Forms for a period of one (1) year. If the Owner/Caretaker is under 18 years of age, the signature of a parent/guardian is required.
2. Rabbits and Cavies must be free of evidence of infectious and contagious diseases. Rabbits and Cavies appearing to be unhealthy upon arrival, including signs of a dangerous transmissible disease and/or bleeding from eyes, nose, mouth or bloody stools, will NOT be allowed to be on the grounds.
 3. Individual animal identification is required for all rabbits and cavies. Official ID includes:
 - a. A permanent identification tattoo in left ear;
 - b. Pet Class entries may have a temporary tattoo placed in the left ear).
