Entry Fee: None

Registration: Youth Ages 5-12. Sign up on the night of the contest at the Stage.

RULES

1. Contestants must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at the time of registration and participation.
2. Parents/Guardian must sign a waiver at time of registration.
3. Contest runs in heats based on age: 5-6, 7-8, 9-10 and 11-12 years old.
4. Contestant may only compete once.
5. Fair reserves the right to limit each class to 10 contestants.
6. Contest rules will be explained at the time of contest by the Fair or its representative.
7. Winner will be determined by the first contestant to completely eat the donut.
8. No utensils of any kind may be used. Hands must not touch the table or plate at any time.
9. If a donut entry falls onto the floor, the contestant is disqualified.
10. Fair will supply donuts and contestant supplies (ex: bibs, water, etc).

2. Certified winner must notify Kimberton Community Fair prior to November 15 concerning their intentions to represent Kimberton Fair at the PA Farm Show competition. If the first-place winner is not going, then Kimberton reserves the right to certify its next place winner.
3. Winner is responsible for getting their entry to the 2027 PA Farm Show.
4. An official Certification Form issued by the PA State Association of County Fairs must accompany the winning entry to the 2027 PA Farm Show.

5. Certified Winner will receive a mailing or email in mid-December with the Official Certification Form and the entry and judging days for Farm Show.

PURPOSE

To encourage the promotion and understanding of agricultural fairs. The Fair Queen and Ambassadors promote our fair and our County's agriculture, while gaining personal and professional growth and development. The Fair Queen Program provides each participant the opportunity to build and enhance confidence in her abilities, poise in her presentations, pride in her accomplishments, skills in communication, knowledge of the fair industry and sportsmanship. A scholarship is presented to the selected Queen, and she will have the opportunity to represent our fair at the PA Fair Queen Contest in **January following the fair year**.

RULES

Each Fair Queen contestant must

1. Be a female who is a U.S. citizen and a resident of Pennsylvania.
2. Be at least age 16, but no older than 20, years of age as of June 1 of the year entering the local contest.
3. Be certified as the winner by the local fair where she was crowned.
4. Have not been a former local Fair Queen winner, nor a former PA Fair Queen contestant.
5. Not hold any other State title for any other commodity group or pageant during her reign.
6. Have her parent(s)' or guardian(s)' consent to enter the competition.
7. Be single, have never been married, have not been pregnant nor given birth to a child.
8. Act in accordance with the PA Fair Queen "Behavior Policy"
9. Meet all time commitments, Queen obligations and "Dress Code" as set forth by the PA Fair Queen Program

FAIR-SPECIFIC RULES

In addition to the State rules, Kimberton Fair has additional contest eligibility, obligations and judging rules. Contact Louise Kritzberger for complete details.

JUDGING CRITERIA

1. **Written essay** on "What Kimberton Community Fair Means To My Community". Essay must be 300 words or less.
2. **3-5 minute Speech** on "Why You Should Come to the Kimberton Community Fair". Cue cards may be utilized. Props may be used if they enhance the speech. Computer based presentations are not permitted. This should be a persuasive speech appropriate for an adult audience.
3. **Personal Interview** with the panel of judges.

AWARD

First Place - \$1,000.00 Scholarship for higher education. Sponsored by Kimberton Community Fair (*winner must meet eligibility requirements*)

Kimberton Fair's Winner becomes eligible to compete at the State Competition in Hershey, PA in **January following the fair year** where 1st place is awarded a \$2,500 scholarship.

SENIOR, JUNIOR & AND LITTLE MISS KIMBERTON FAIR

JUDGING CRITERIA - Senior Miss

1. **Written Essay** - "How Technology Affects My Fair" (Cue cards may be used)
2. **3-4 minute Speech** "Why should I care about Agriculture?" (Cue cards may be used)
3. **Personal Interview** with the panel of judges.

JUDGING CRITERIA - Junior Miss

1. **2-3 minute Speech** "Why the Kimberton Fair is important to Chester County" (Cue cards may be

used).

2. **Personal Interview** with the panel of judges.

JUDGING CRITERIA - Little Miss

1. **Poster Presentation** "What I like most about Kimberton Fair"
2. **Personal Interview** with the panel of judges.
